Biography

"The talismanic qualities of the reused, the resourceful, and the strange come together in Hannah Cutts' work to celebrate an inseparability of life and art. In a truly Duchampian twist on evaluating what is unique, finding is the creative act for her, and thus she amasses carefully chosen, commonplace objects to suggest a poesis of the many.

Interchange, repetition and transformation are her focal points -- whether occurring in Nature's rhythms or within the ebb and flow of capital relationships. For Cutts, recognizing little distinction between high and low culture leads to present awareness, and translates into a vital engagement with life's imperfectability. The orgiastic infinity transmitted by consumer culture and within Nature herself acts as a starting point for reappraisal of the original, and in turn of the concept of free will.

Hannah holds a Bachelor of Art in Visual Communication, Design College of Australia, Griffith University, Design College of Australia. Hannah received a national scholarsjip to study an International Baccalaureate at the United World College of the Atlantic, Wales. Her work has been shown both nationally and internationally and is included in Artbank's collection."

Hannah Cutts grew up in England and Africa. At 19, Cutts moved to Brisbane where she studied Architecture. Two years into the degree she moved back to London where she worked as a shop designer and photographer for Ted Baker. When the contract ended Hannah moved back to Brisbane to study Visual Arts at QCA.

Cutts was contracted as a childrens book illustrator by Macmillan and was resident illustrator at the Independant Magazine.

Hannah formed a company called Cutts Creative in 1995. Cutts Creative was known for its branding, artbased graphic design and environmental graphiucs and site specific artworks.

Hannah has had many solo shows since the late 90's... starting with a solo illustration exhibition at Spring Hill Baths in 1993... Metro Arts, Group show at QGA, 4 shows with Edwina Corlette Gallery, Group show at Redland Art Gallery, Artbank in Sydney. Works are in the collections of Moreton Bay Shire Council, Artbank, Wesley Hospital, Torrens University.

This year hannah will be showing at the Third Quarter in Brisbane, the Murwillumbah Arts Trail and has recently been asked to submit works for the CITY OF LIGHTS programme run by BRISBANE CITY COUNCIL.




